



















Alcohol Use on Holiday

















Drug Use and Fighting







Logistic Regression













Factors independently associated with being involved in fights:

- o Male
- Choosing destination due to nightlife
- Longer length of stay
- High financial level
- Using tobacco on holiday
- Using cannabis on holiday
- Frequent drunkenness
