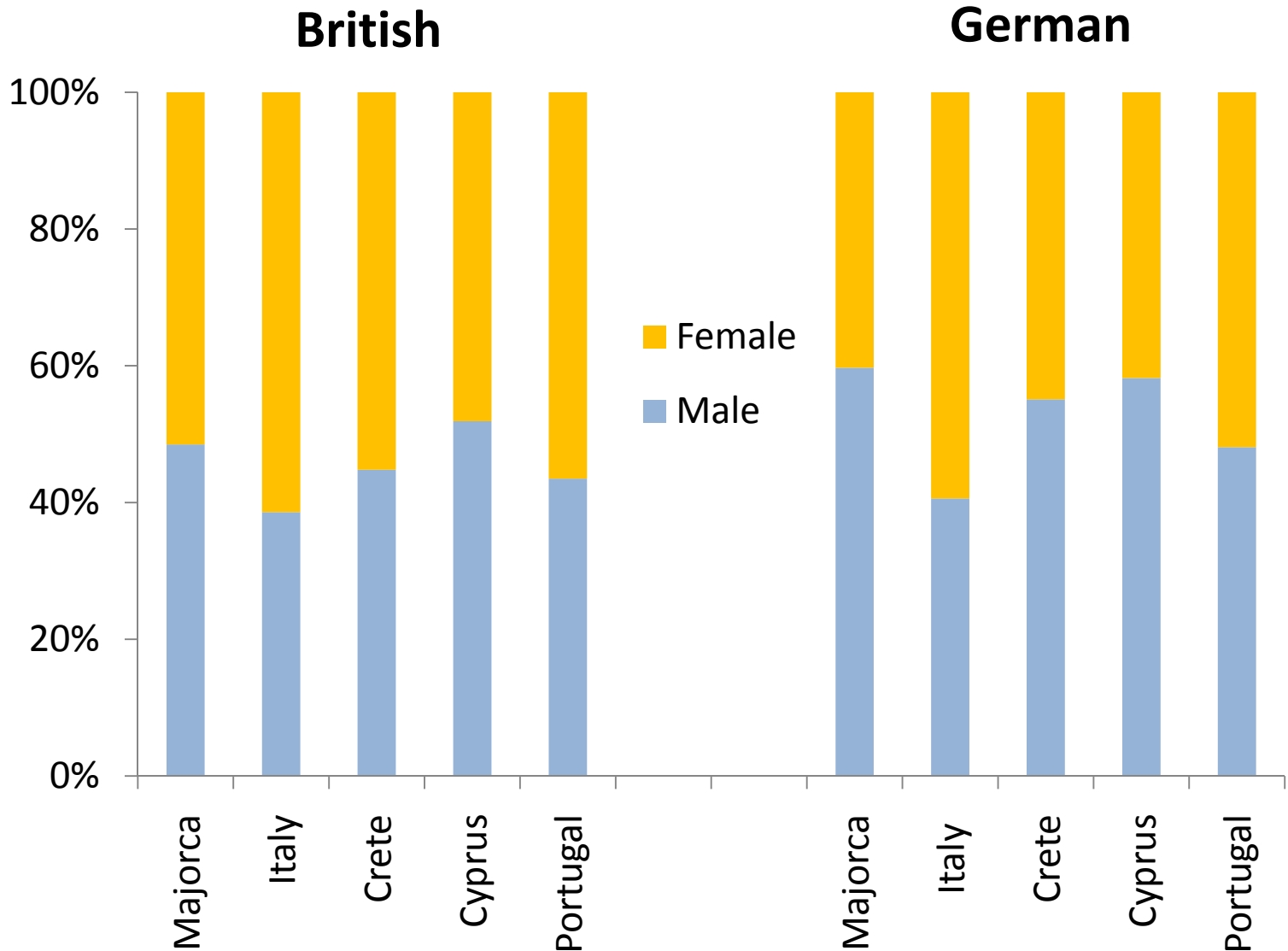

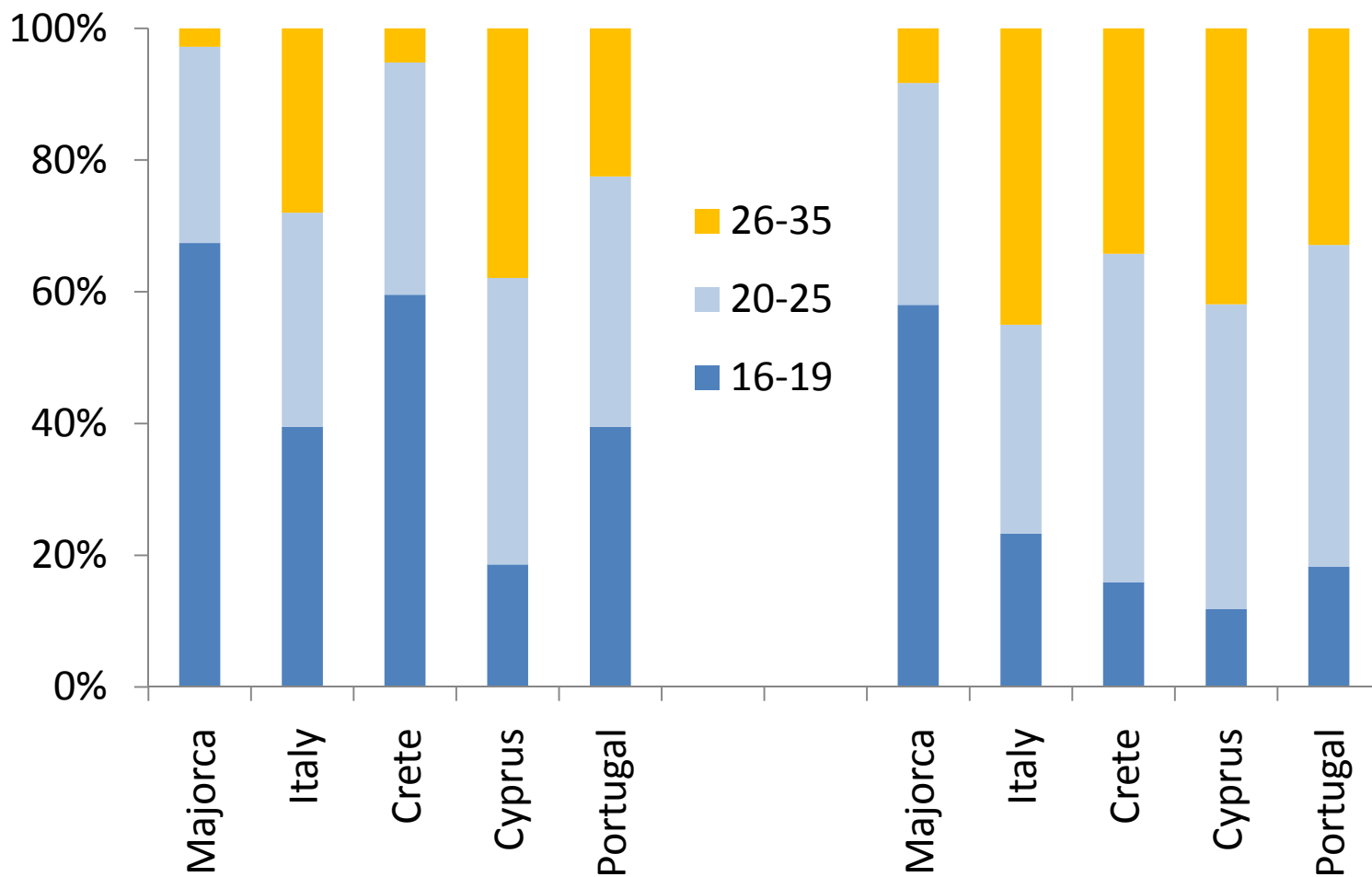


The Sample - Age

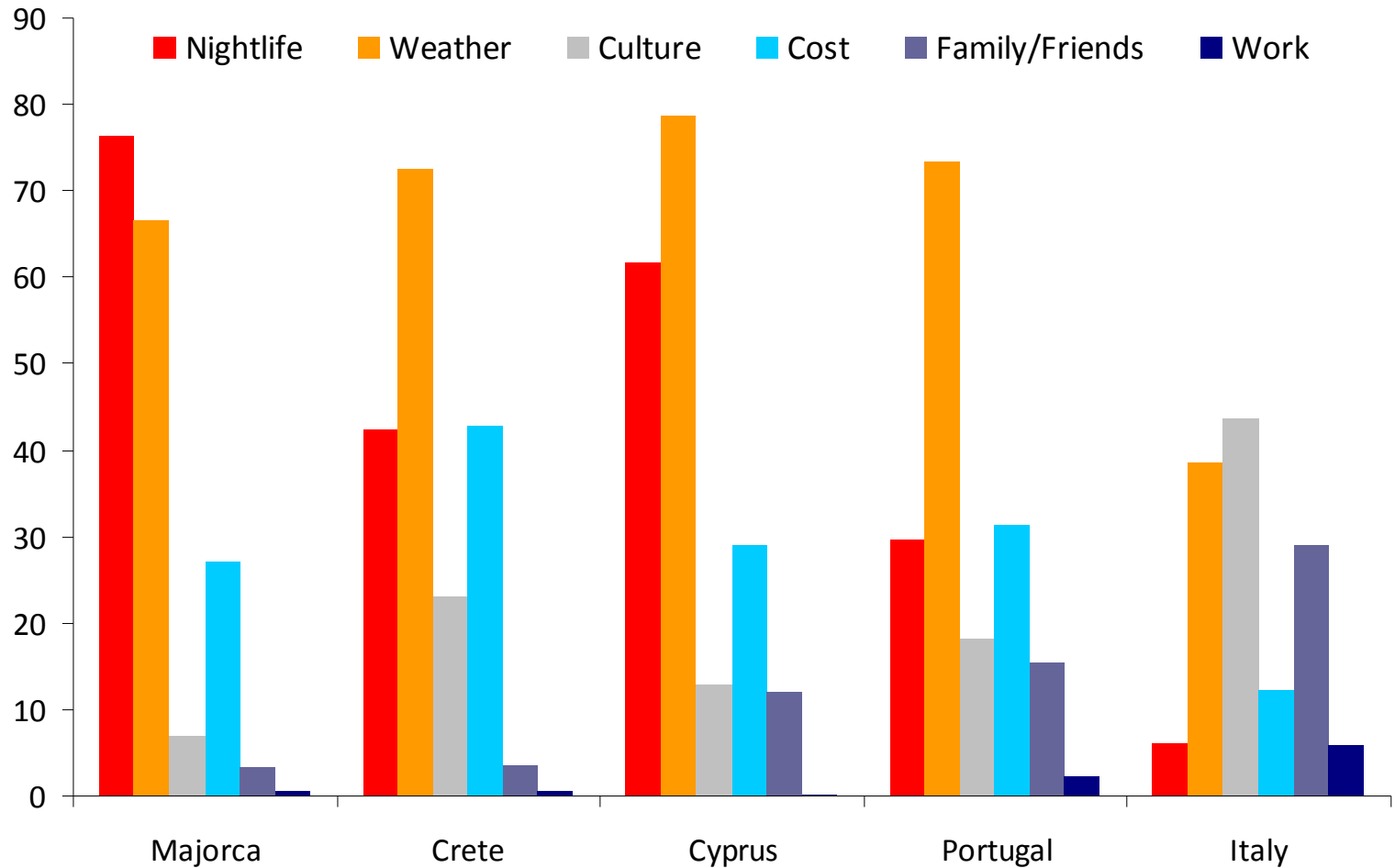

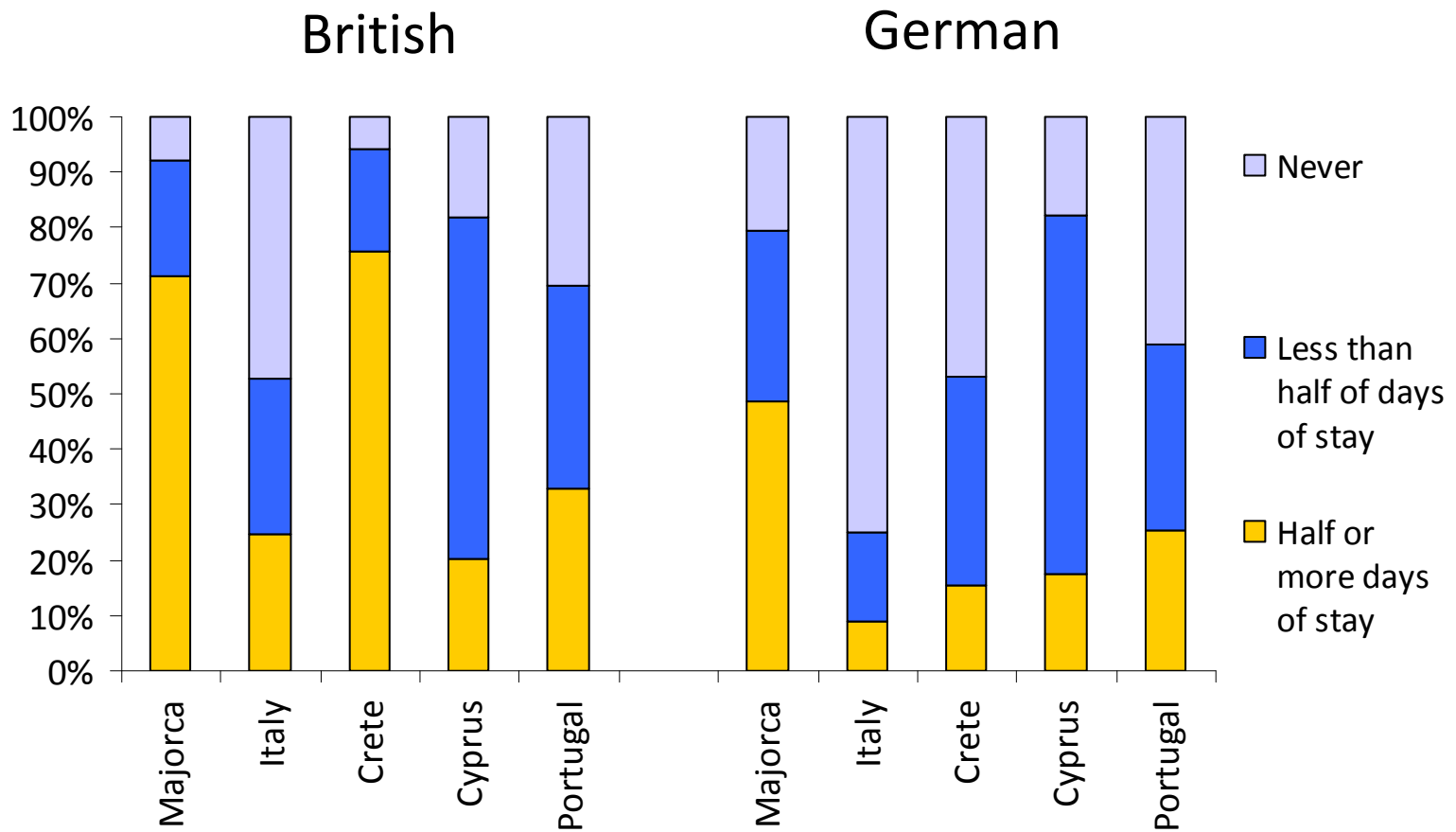

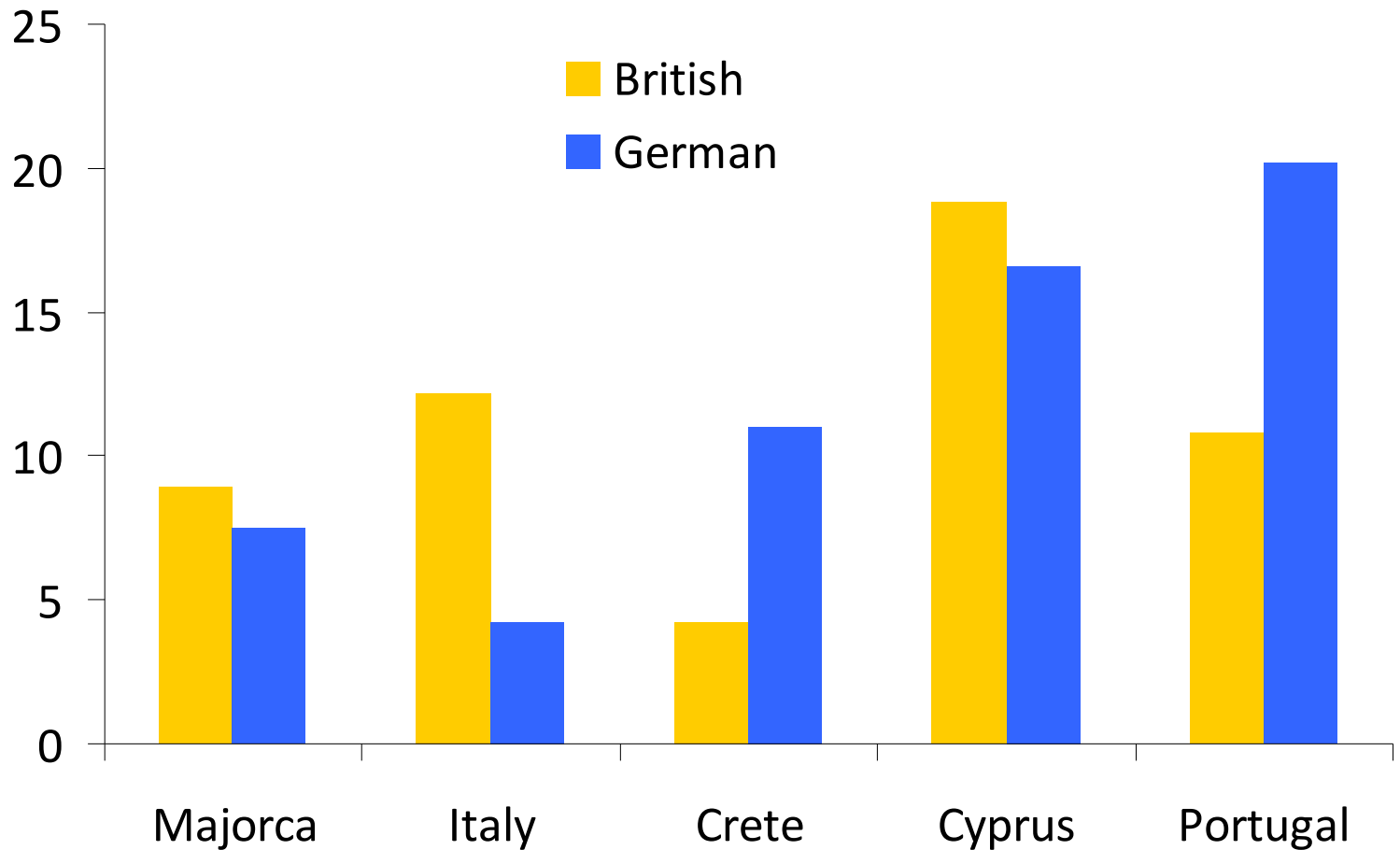
Alcohol Use on Holiday

Drug Use on Holiday

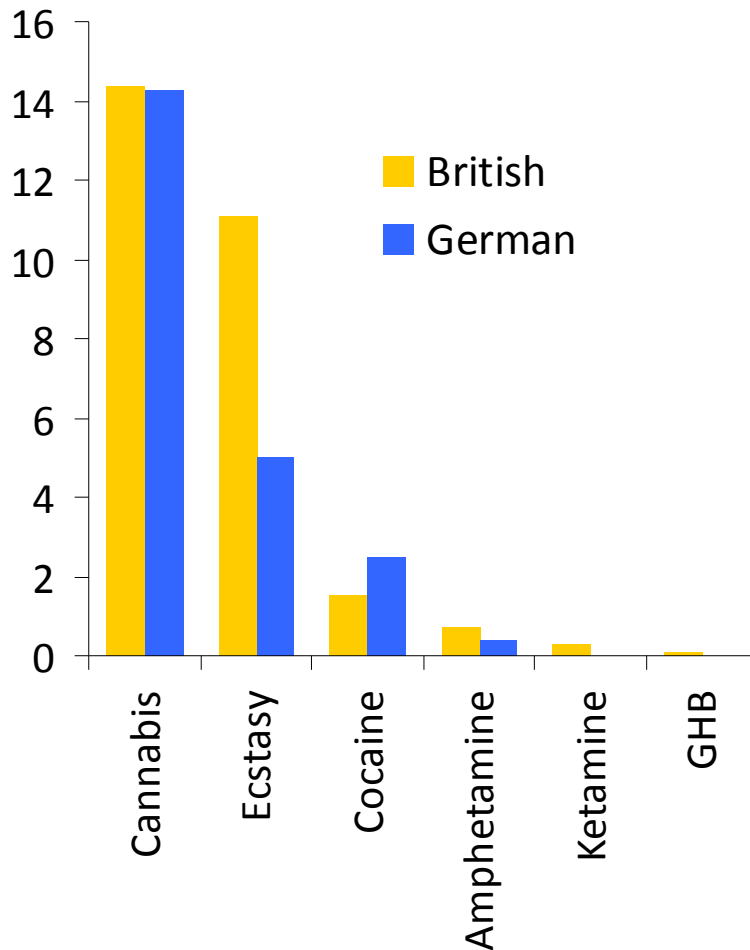
% using any illicit drug on holiday



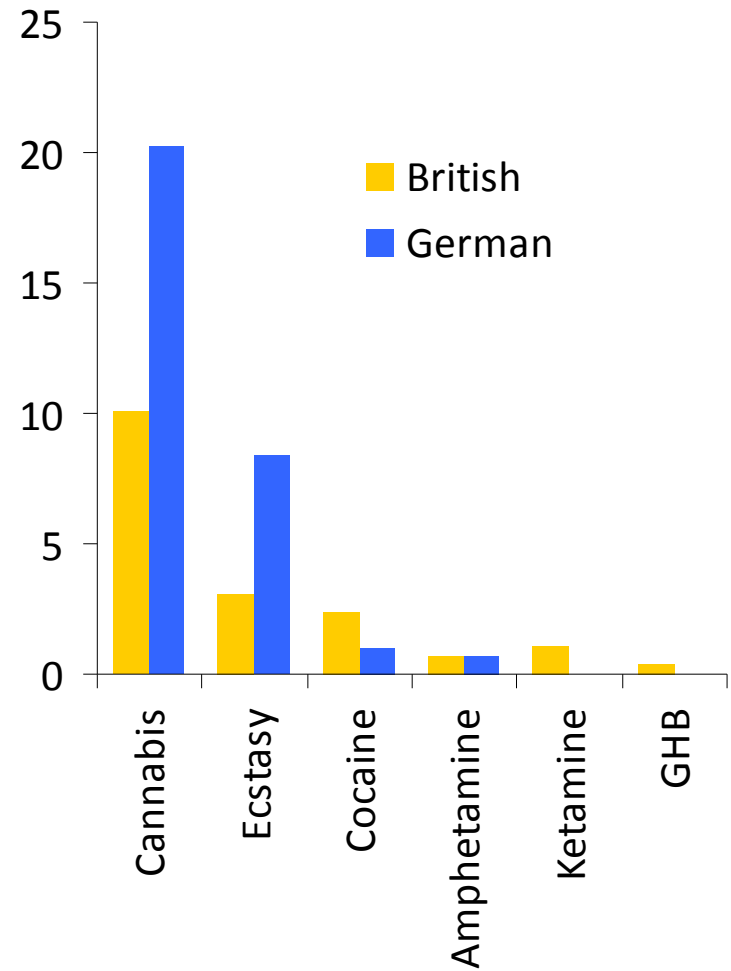

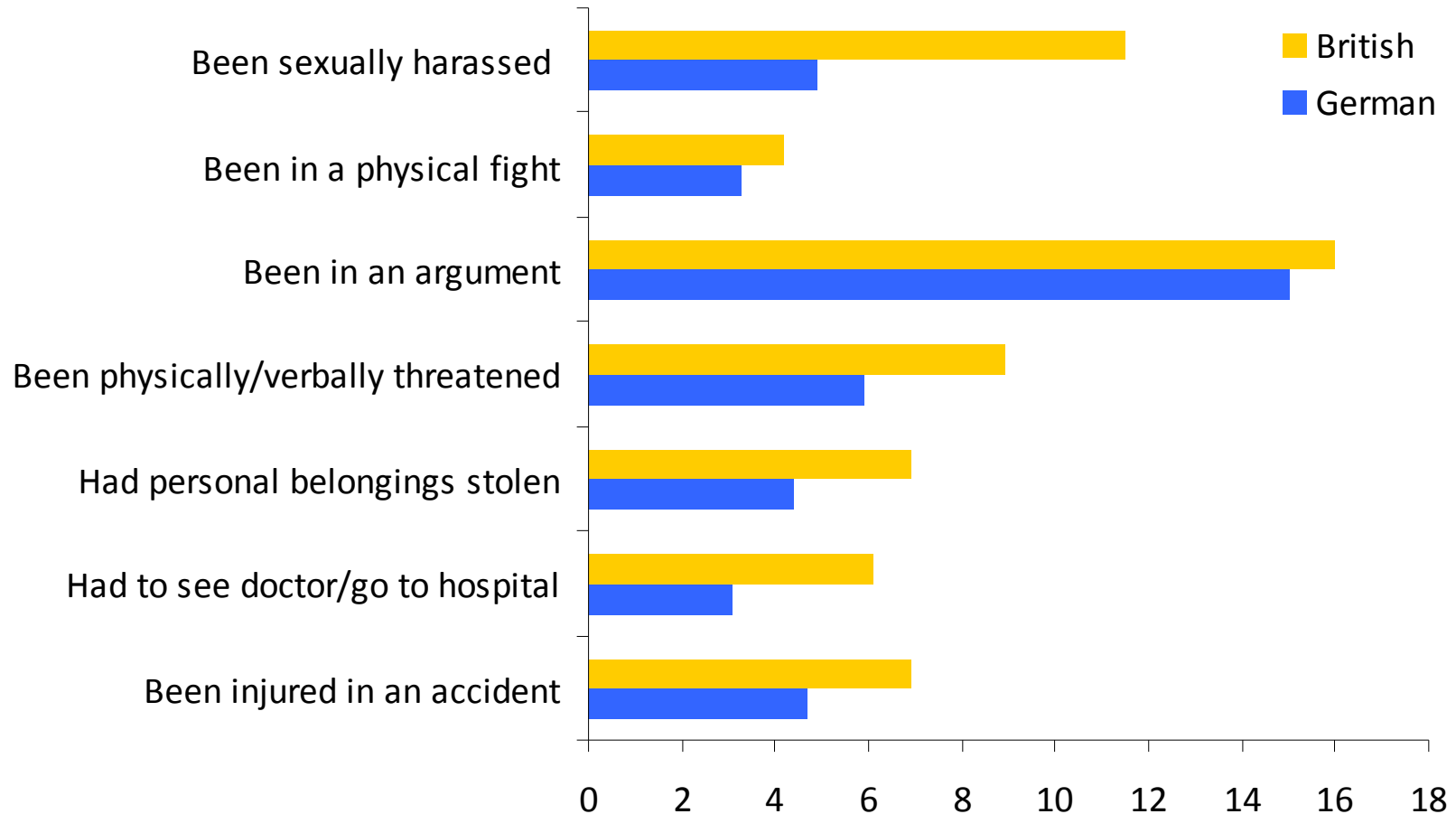

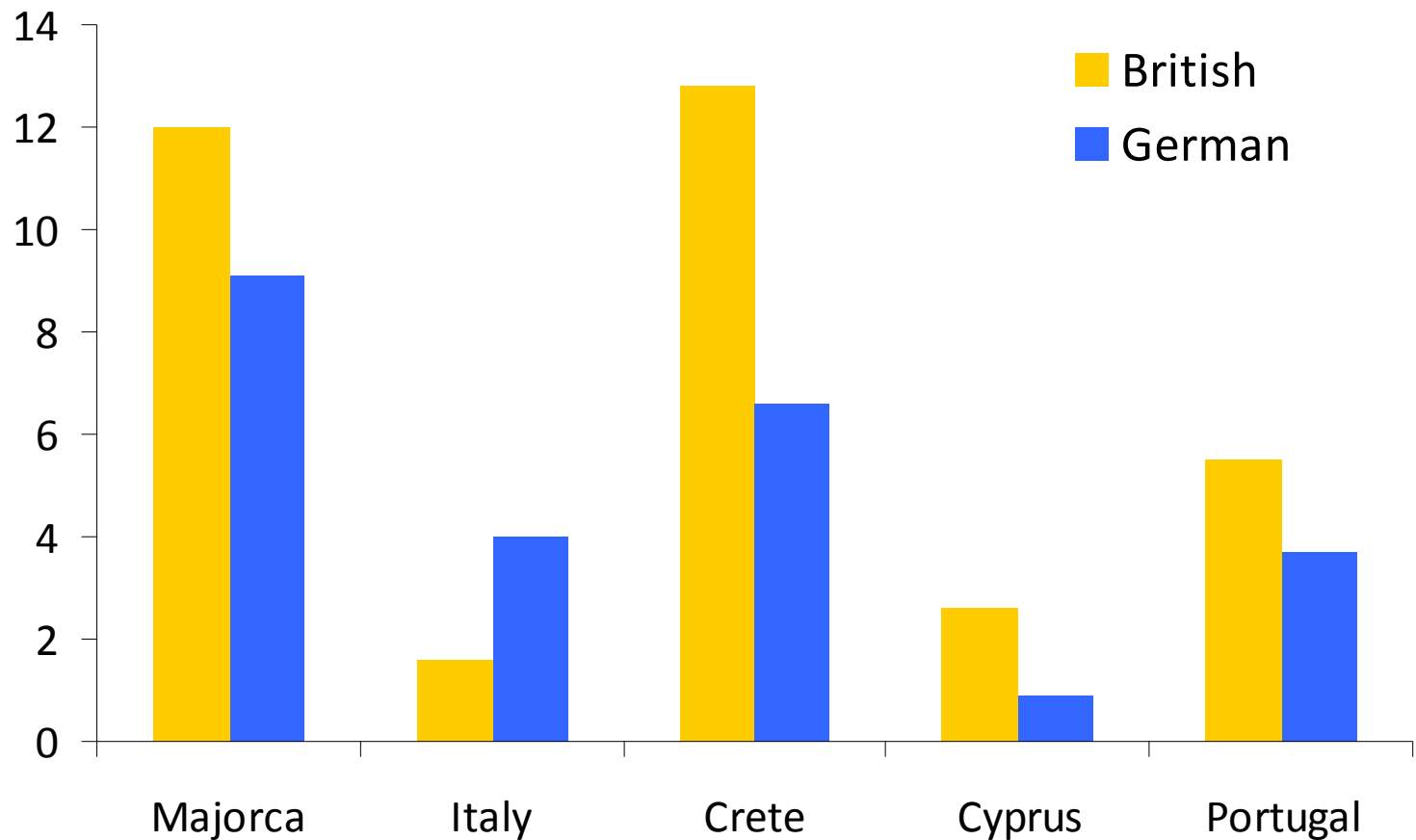

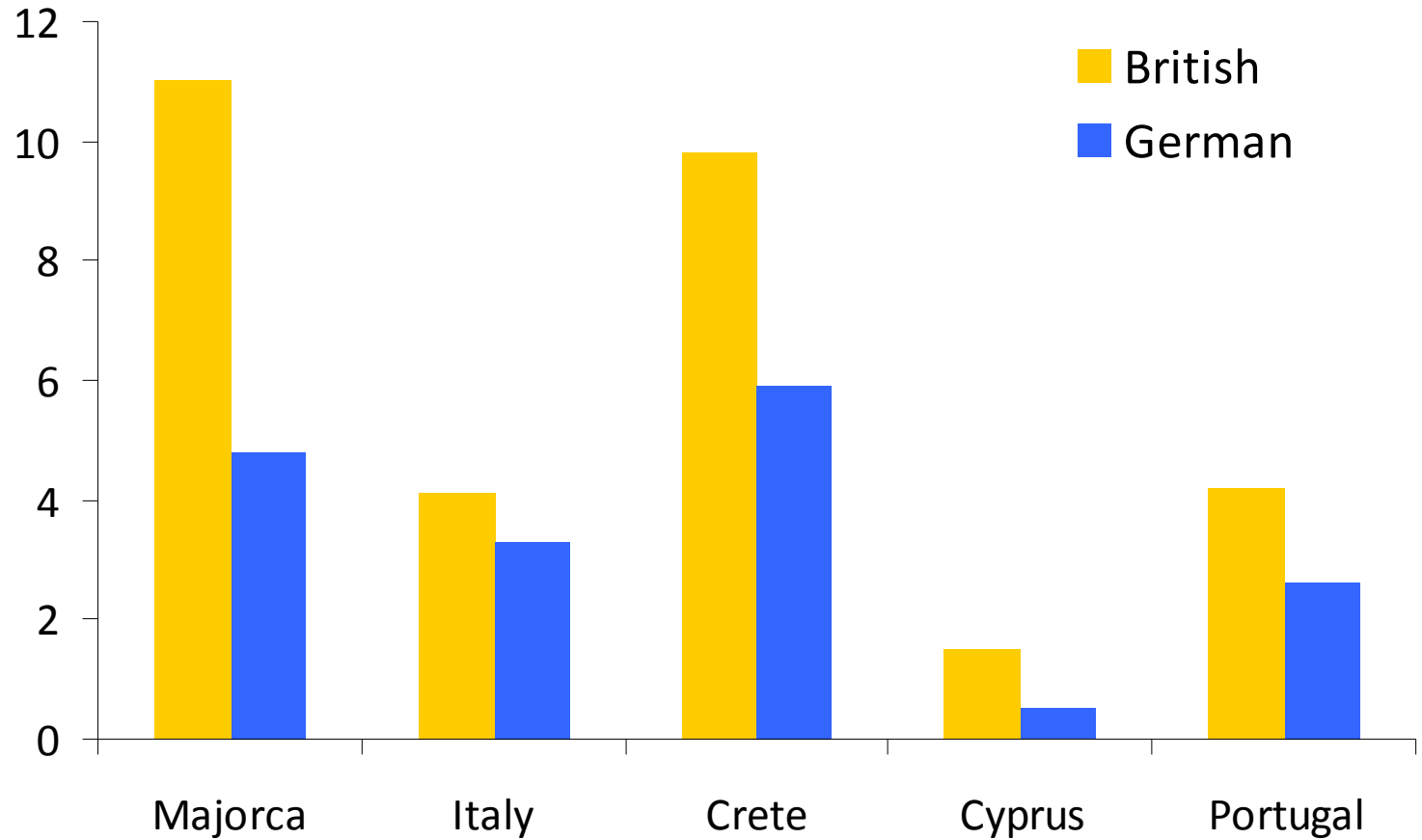

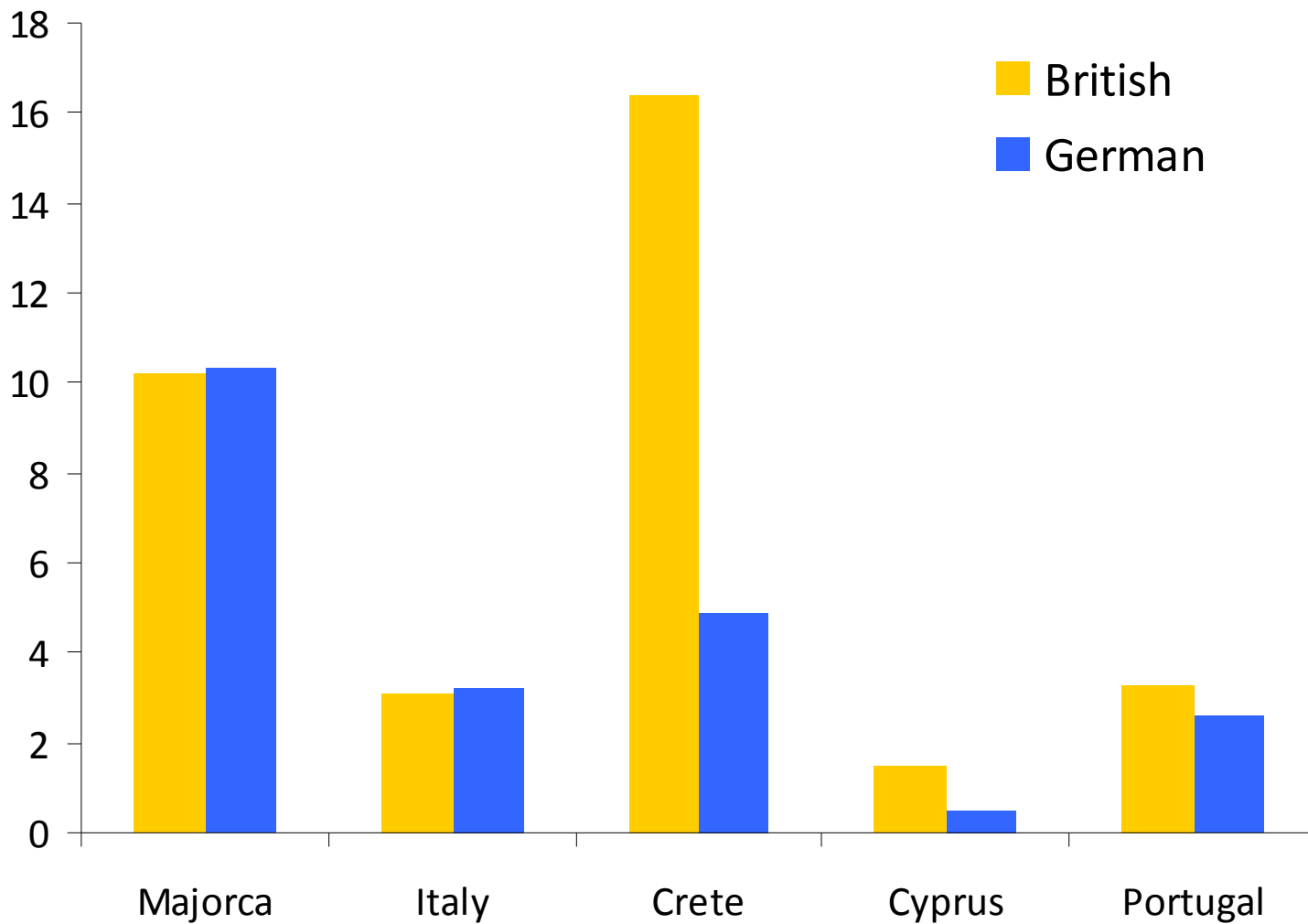

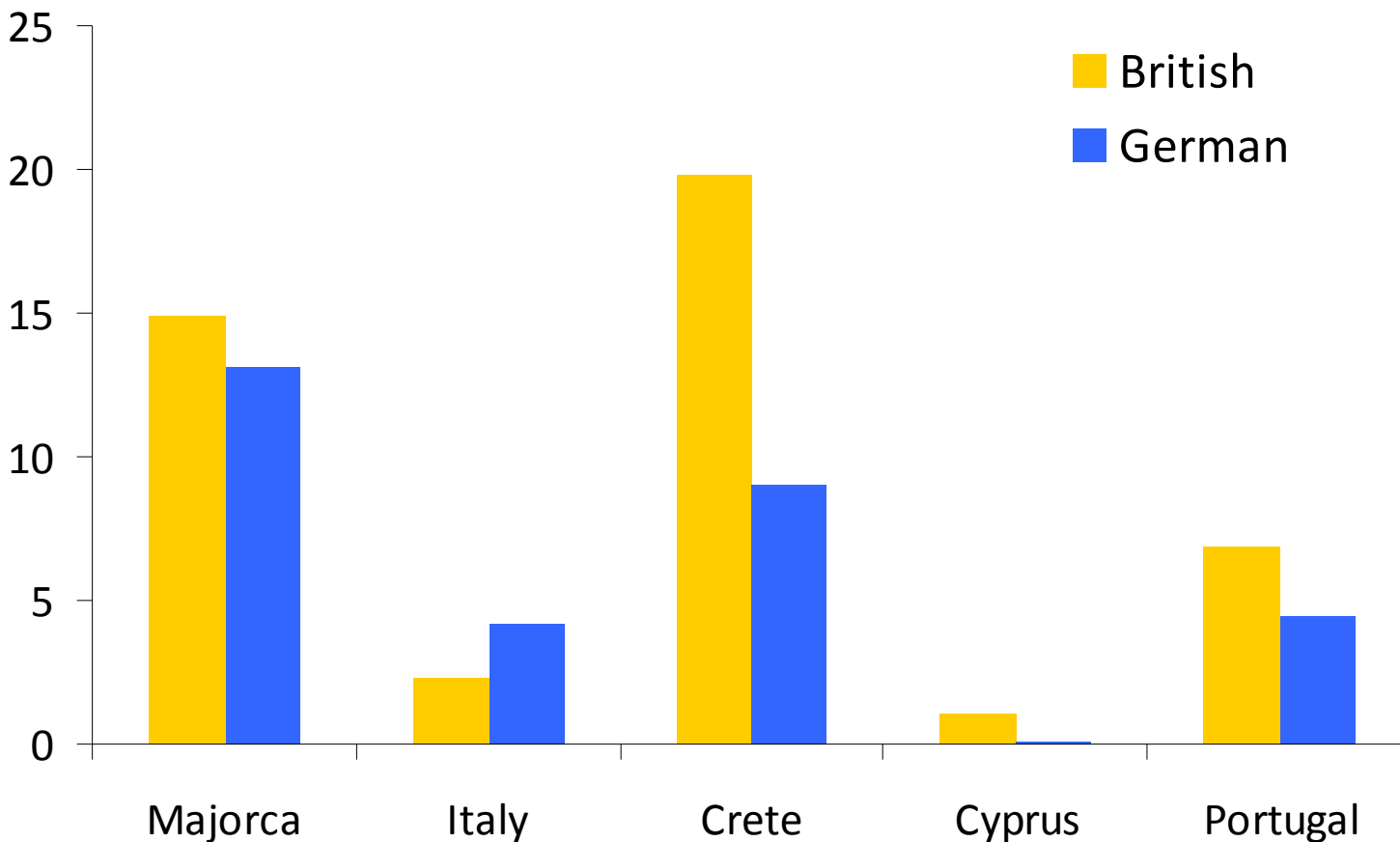

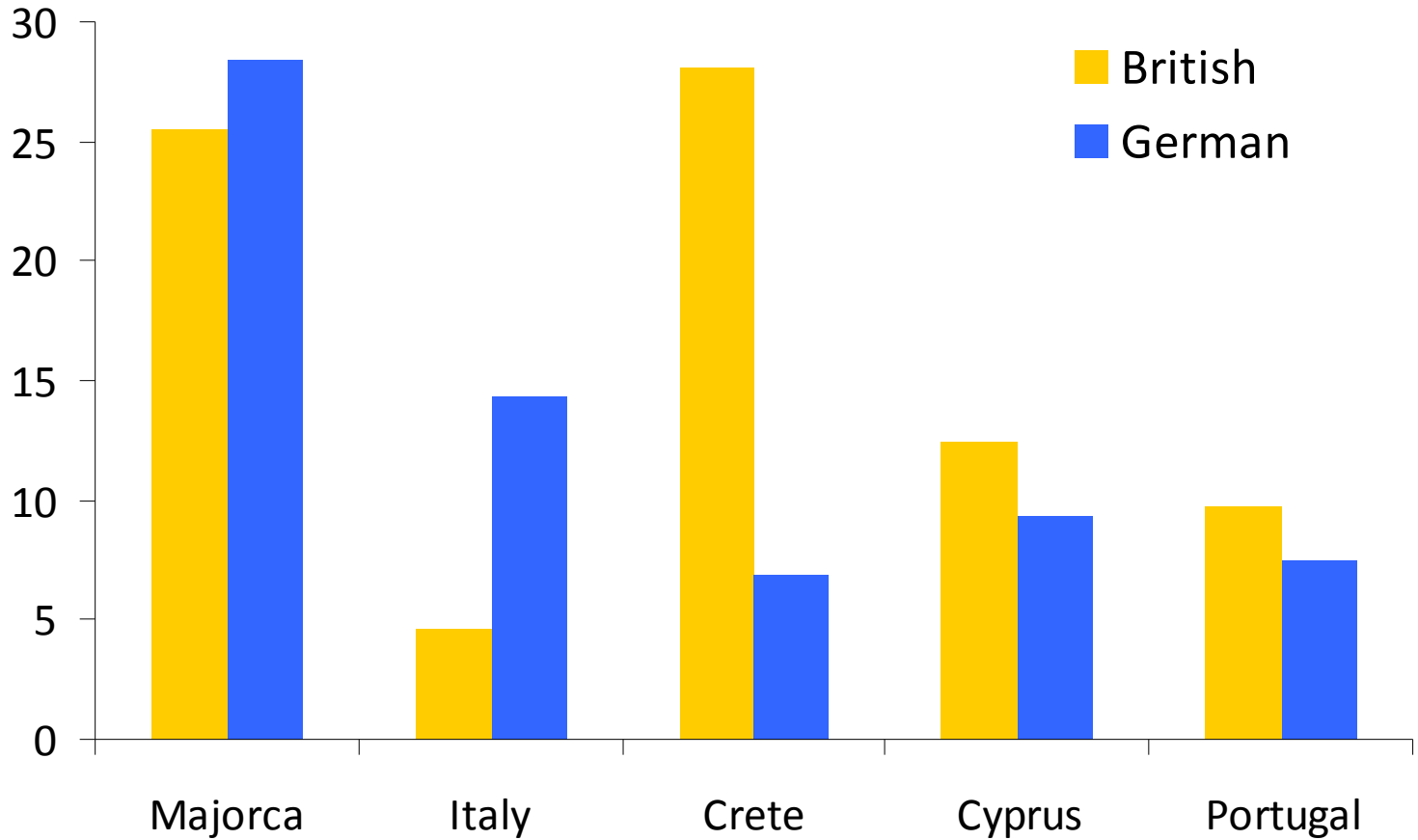

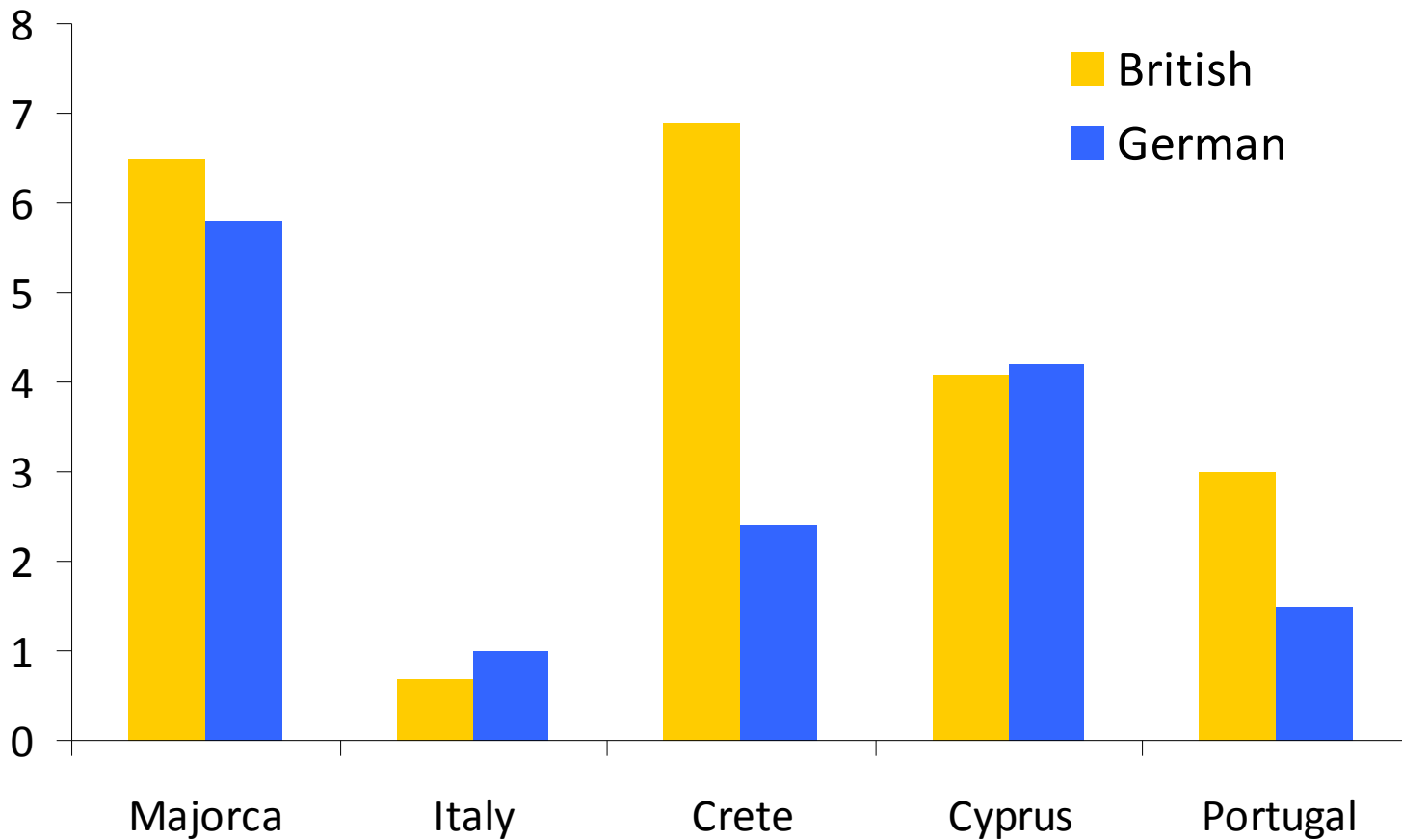

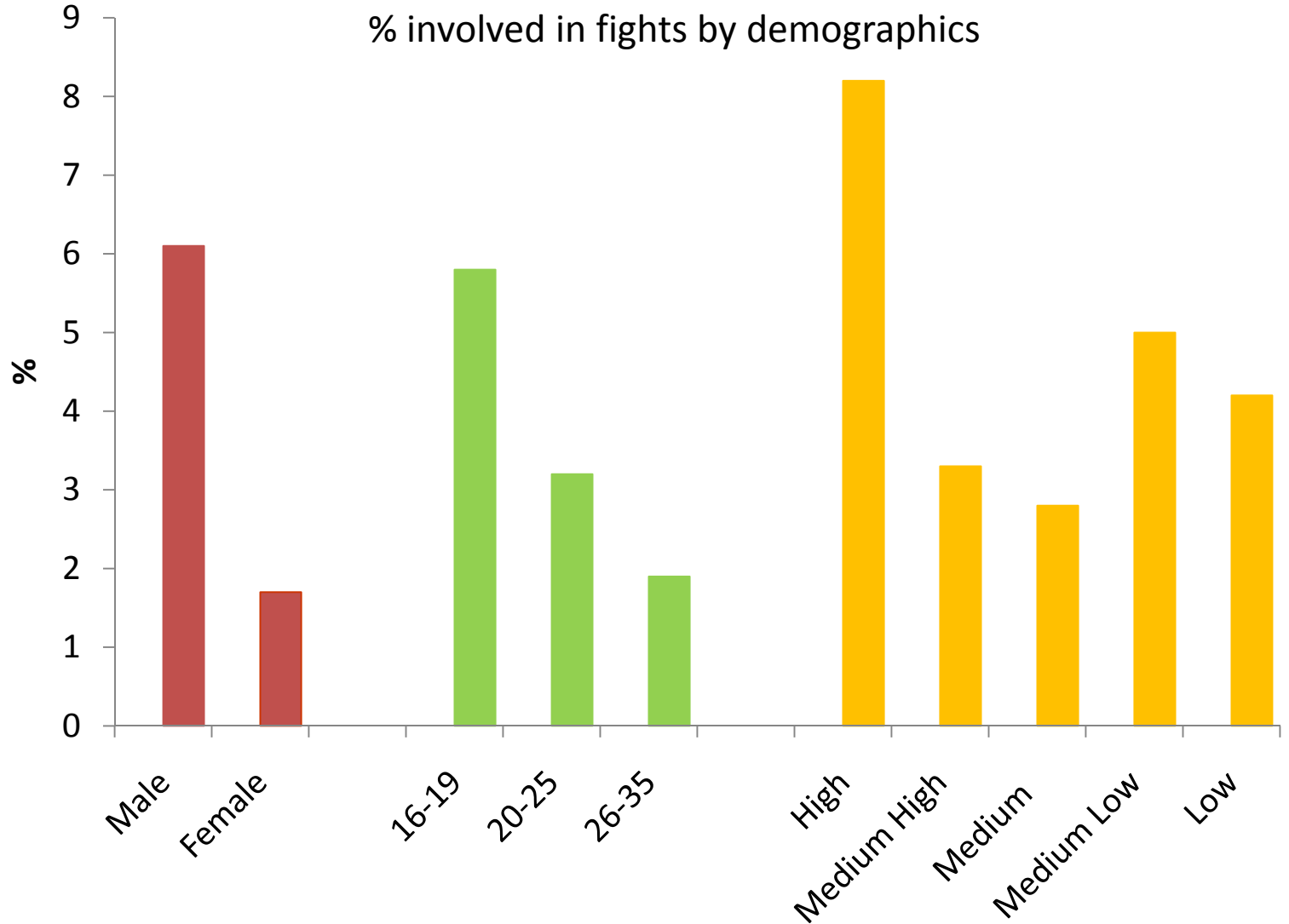

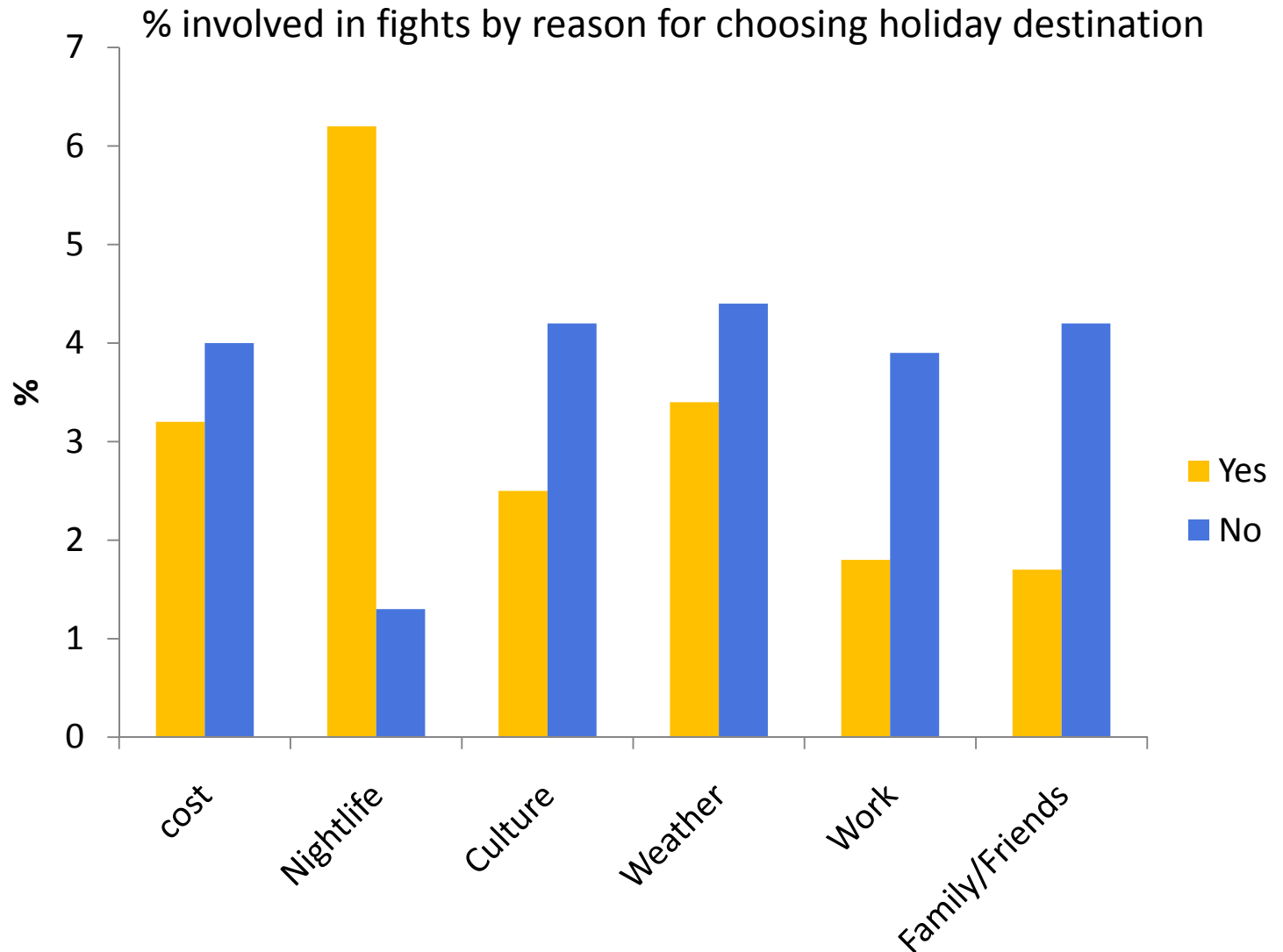

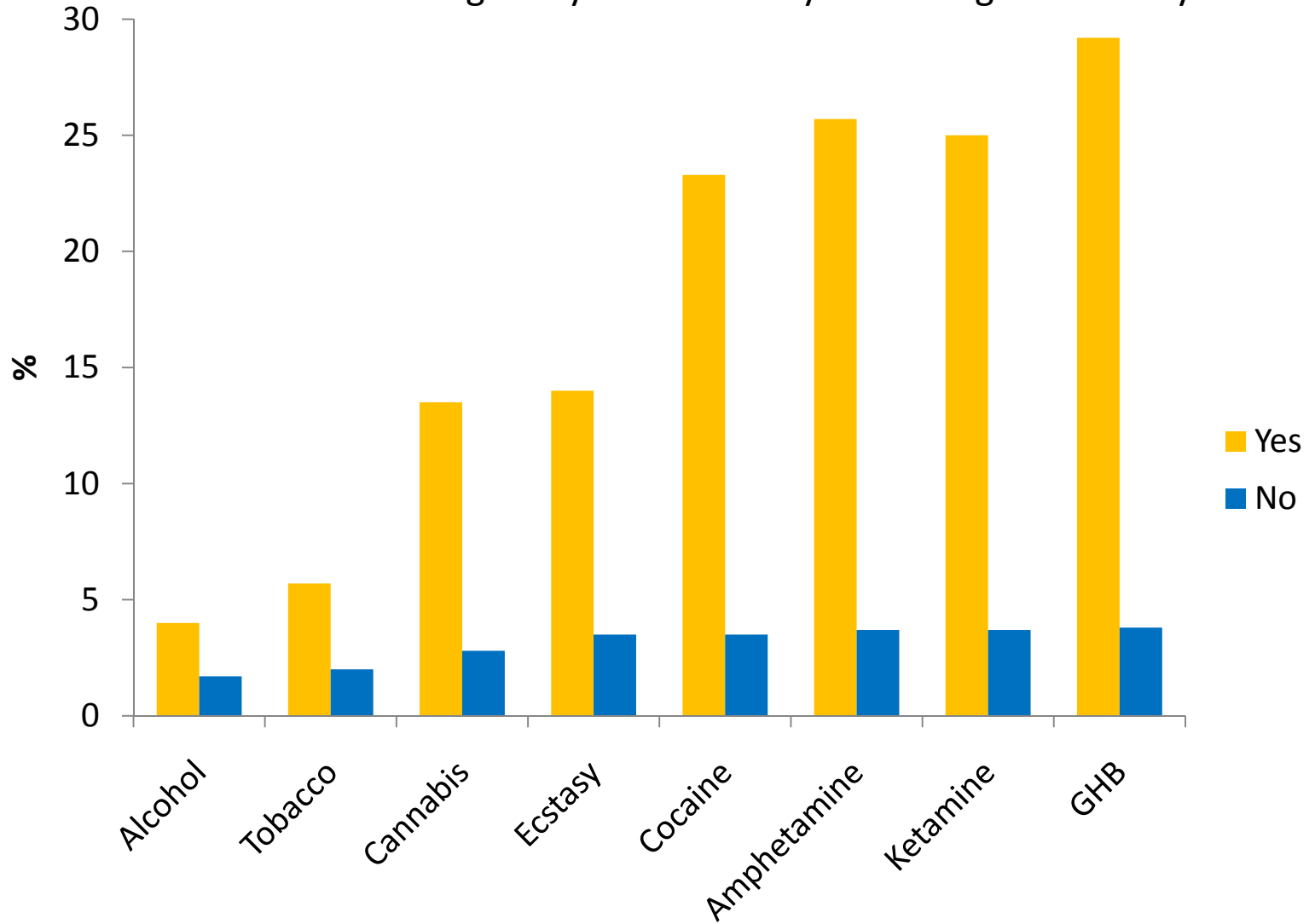

Logistic Regression

- Factors independently associated with being involved in fights:

- Male
- Choosing destination due to nightlife
- Longer length of stay
- High financial level
- Using tobacco on holiday
- Using cannabis on holiday
- Frequent drunkenness
